

Adult Vaccines Protect You, Your Family and Community



Did you know?

- Pertussis (whooping cough) is also known as the 100-day cough
- Human Papillomavirus vaccine is the 2nd vaccine to prevent cancer, Hepatitis B vaccine was the first!
- As many as 5 out of every 100 people who get shingles will get them again
- About 500 children in the U.S. die each year from vaccine preventable diseases, About 50,000 adults also die.

Adults that are un-insured or under-insured (your insurance does not cover immunizations) may be eligible for free vaccines through the Health Department.

A \$13 administration fee per vaccine would apply.

- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap/Td)
- Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)
- *Varicella, also known as chickenpox
- *Pneumococcal (PPSV23)
- Hepatitis B
- Hepatitis A
- *Zoster, also known as shingles
- *Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
