Free Community Wide Drive-Thru COVID-19 Testing Available in Dickinson and Iron Counties

Iron River and Kingsford, Michigan – July 10, 2020. The Dickinson-Iron District Health Department, Michigan National Guard and Emergency Management have partnered to provide free community drive-thru COVID-19 testing in Dickinson and Iron Counties. Please note this is not an antibody test, it is a PCR test (nasal swab).

The Dickinson county drive-thru clinic will take place at the Kingsford school (MS/HS parking lot) on Friday, July 24th from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

The Iron county drive-thru clinic will take place at the Forest Park School (student parking lot) on Saturday, July 25th from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

All testing is free of charge and available for anyone 18 years and older who wish to be tested. A doctor's order is not necessary. Participants will be required to bring a driver's license or photo. I.D. to register. Upon arrival to the testing sites, all participants will be asked to wear a mask and roll windows of vehicle down no more than 2 inches to allow for communication.
