DIDHD offering NEHA Food Safety Training Course

Kingsford and Iron River, Michigan – January 10, 2023. The Dickinson-Iron District Health Department will be offering a National Environmental Health Association (NEHA) Food Safety Training “**Manager Certification Course**”.

This course will ensure that food managers and supervisors have the necessary tools to educate their staff on the best practices of food handling. Most licensed food establishments must have a certified manager.

You can choose to attend the 2-day class that will be held Tuesday, February 7, 2023 and Thursday February 9, 2023. The cost is \$185.00. Or take the test only on Thursday February 9, 2023. The cost is \$35.00.

The classes will be held at the Sagola Community Building, 306 1St St. (off of Hwy M-69) in Sagola, MI. Pre-registration is required. The class is limited to 20 people. You are not registered until we receive payment. Registration is due by Tuesday, January 31, 2023.
